# **AROUND POLLOK**

# MACAROONS RECPIE

They say these are traditional Scottish Macaroons but when did you ever see a coconut tree in Pollok. They are delicious mind you and here's how your granny made them.

#### **INGRIEDENTS**

120g cooled mashed potato (1/2 cup) 450-500g icing sugar (3 ½-4 cups) 300g dark chocolate (1 ¾ cups) 140g desiccated coconut (1 1/3 cups)

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Line a baking tray with greaseproof paper.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl combine the mashed potato and icing sugar. It will become runny but thicken after five to ten minutes.
- 3. Shape the mixture on the greaseproof paper.
- 4. Place the baking tray in the freezer for 45 minutes.
- 5. Add half of the coconut to a frying pan and lightly toast until golden brown. Mix with the rest of the coconut.
- 6. Melt the chocolate in the microwave.
- 7. Dip your potato/sugar mixture from the freezer and dip in the coconut. Then coat with coconut before the chocolate sets.
- 8. Eat until you have totally sickened yourself.
